In exercise of the powers conferred under section 35 of RGUHS Act, 1994 and pursuant to the recommendations of Academic Council in its meeting held on 10/11/2014, the Syndicate in its 110th meeting held on 21/11/2014 is pleased to notify the ordinance relating to submission of dissertation by students pursuing superspeciality courses in Medicine.

9. Dissertation

- 9.1 Every candidate pursuing DM/M.Ch degree course is required to carry out work on a selected research project under the guidance of a recognized post graduate teacher. The results of such a work shall be submitted in the form of a **dissertation**.
- 9.2 The dissertation is aimed to train a post graduate student in research methods and techniques. It includes identification of a problem, formulation of a hypothesis, search and review of literature, getting acquainted with Research advances, designing of a research study, collection of data, critical analysis and comparison of results and drawing conclusions.
- 9.3 Every candidate shall submit to the Registrar (Academic) of the University in the prescribed proforma, a synopsis containing particulars of proposed dissertation work within six months from the date of commencement of course on or before the dates notified by the University. The synopsis shall be sent through the proper channel, in soft and hard copies.
- 9.4 Such synopsis will be reviewed and the dissertation topic will be registered by the University. No change in the dissertation topic or guide shall be done without prior approval of the University.
- 9.5 The dissertation should be written under the following headings:


PART A)	i. Introduction ii. Aims or Objectives of study with justification iii. Review of Literature iv. Material and Methods
PART B)	v. Results vi. Discussion vii. Conclusion viii. Summary
PART C)	ix. Tables x. Annexures xi. References

PART A shall be concise and brief.

- 9.6 The written text of dissertation shall be not less than 50 pages and shall not exceed 70 pages excluding references, tables, questionnaires and other annexures. It should be neatly typed in double line spacing on one side of paper (A4 size, 8.27" x 11.69") and bound properly. Spiral binding should be avoided. The dissertation shall be certified by the guide, head of the department and head of the Institution.
- 9.7 Four copies (2 soft and 2 hard bound copies) of dissertation thus prepared shall be submitted to the Registrar (Evaluation), six months before final examination on or before the dates notified by the University.
- 9.8 The dissertation shall be valued by examiners appointed by the University. Approval of dissertation work is an essential precondition for a candidate to appear in the University examination.
- 9.9 Guide: The academic qualification and teaching experience required for recognition by this University as a guide for dissertation work is as per Medical Council of India Minimum Qualifications for Teachers in Medical Institutions Regulations, 1998.
- A Co-guide may be included provided the work requires substantial contribution from a sister department or from another medical institution recognized for teaching/training by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences/Medical Council of India. The co-guide shall be a recognized post graduate teacher of Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences.
- 9.10 Change of guide: In the event of a registered guide leaving the college for any reason or in the event of death of guide, guide may be changed with prior permission from the University.

The Notification shall come into force with immediate effect.
