As per the decision of the Syndicate in its 128th meeting held on 23.08.2017 and in exercise of the powers conferred under section 35(2) of RGUHS Act, 1994, it is hereby notified that the following guidelines for attending the NA/NR mismatch problems encountered in valuation of UG, PG and superspecialty examination answer scripts.

SI No	Problems Encountered	Guidelines to be followed
1.	One valuator has given marks another valuator has marked NA/NR. But student has written the answers.	To award the same marks awarded by one of the examiner
2.	One valuator has given marks, another valuator marked NA/NR. But student has not written the answer.	To consider the question as "not answered" and to withdraw the marks awarded for the question.
3.	Both the valutors have marked NR, but student has written the answer.	To subject the particular question for valuation by two examiners independently.
4.	Both the valutors have given marks, but student has not written the answer.	To withdraw the marks awarded by the examiners.
5.	Student has written the answer but wrongly mentioned the Question Number.	To get the particular answer valued and to recover the cost of revaluation from the student.
6.	Student has written the answer but not mentioned the Question number	To subject the answers for valuation and to recover the cost of revaluation from the student.
7.	Student has written the answer but one valuator given marks and another valuator marked hyphen (-).	To consider the marks awarded by one of the examiners by cancelling hyphen (-).

This Notification shall come into force with effect from the examination conducted on or after 01.11.2016 and onwards.
