NOTIFICATION

- Sub: Amendment to the revised ordinance of BAMS RS 4 (NS) course.
Ref: 1.Revised Ordinance 2014 of RGUHS Governing BAMS RS 4 & RS 4 (NS) Course In Ayurveda.
2 .Gazette notification dated: 07.11.2016, relating to pass and promotion criteria.
3 .Minutes of the 124th Syndicate meeting held on 6th January 2017.

In exercise of the powers conferred under section 35 of RGUHS Act 1994, the Syndicate in its meeting held on 06.01.2017 decided to notify Amendment to the revised Ordinance of RS4 & RS 4 (NS) Ayurveda course, relating to pass criteria and promotion to next higher class as been below:

- The failed student of first professional shall be allowed to appear in second professional examination, but the student shall not be allowed to appear in third professional examination unless the student passes all the subjects of first professional examination and maximum four chances shall be given to pass first professional examination within a maximum period of 3 years.
- The failed student of second professional who has passed all the subjects of first professional examination shall be allowed to appear in third professional examination, but the student shall not be allowed to appear in final professional examination unless the student passes all the subjects of second professional examination and maximum four chances shall be given to pass second professional examination within a maximum period of 3 years.
- The failed student of third professional who has passed all the subjects of first and second professional examination shall be allowed to appear in final professional examination and maximum four chances shall be given to pass third professional examination within a maximum period of 3 years.
- The students failed in any of the four professional examinations in four chances shall not be allowed to continue his or her studies, provided that in case of serious personal illness of student and in any unavoidable circumstances, the Vice chancellor of the University may provide one more chance in any one of four professional examinations.
- To become eligible for joining the compulsory internship programme, all four professional examinations shall be passed within a period of maximum 9 years including all chances as mentioned above.

The passing criteria shall be adopted with immediate implementation for the current RS 4 & RS4 (NS) schemes of BAMS examinations for all the existing batches with immediate effect.

This notification shall come into force with immediate effect.

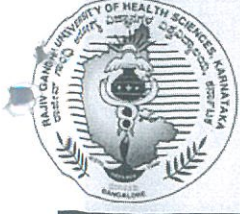

Clarification in continuation with the notification issued dated 13.02.2017 regarding passing criteria and carry over basis (COB) for RS4-BAMS

I. To appear / eligibility for 4th year (final year) exam RS4 -BAMS

1. The failed students of 3rd year
 - a. Who have passed in all the subjects of 1st year and 2nd year
 - b. The students who have attended 1 ½ year (one year and six months) in 4th year subjects and completed a term of 4 ½ years
 - c. The students having 75% of attendance both in theory and practical / as per RGUHS Norms are only eligible for appearing final year exam tentatively schedule from 28.02.2017.

II. Similarly to appear / eligibility for 3rd year exam.

- a. Who have passed in all subjects of 1st year
- b. The Students who have attended 1 year period (one year) in 3 year subjects
- c. The Students who are having 75% of attendance both in theory and practical classes as per RGUHS Norms are eligible

III. Similarly to appear / eligibility for 2nd year exam

- a. The students who have attended 1 year in second year subjects
- b. The Students who are having 75% attendance both in Theory and Practical classes as per RGUHS Norms are eligible

Note: Any violation of above criteria / by giving false information by the Head of the Institution (Principal / Dean) will be subjected to disciplinary action by the University.

**Clarification in continuation with the notification issued dated

I. To appear / eligibility for 4th year (final year) exam RS4 -BAMS

1. The failed students of 3rd year
 - a. Who have passed in all the subjects of 1st year and 2nd year
 - b. The students who have attended 1 ½ year (one year and six months) in 4th year subjects and completed a term of 4 ½ years
 - c. The students having 75% of attendance both in theory and practical / as per RGUHS Norms are only eligible for appearing final year exam tentatively schedule from 28.02.2017.

II. Similarly to appear / eligibility for 3rd year exam.

- a. Who have passed in all subjects of 1st year
- b. The Students who have attended 1 year period (one year) in 3 year subjects
- c. The Students who are having 75% of attendance both in theory and practical classes as per RGUHS Norms are eligible

III. Similarly to appear / eligibility for 2nd year exam

- a. The students who have attended 1 year in second year subjects
- b. The Students who are having 75% attendance both in Theory and Practical classes as per RGUHS Norms are eligible

Note: Any violation of above criteria / by giving false information by the Head of the Institution (Principal / Dean) will be subjected to disciplinary action by the University.
