Pursuant to the MCI Notification referred at (3) above, for admission to MBBS course, the following shall be added in the Revised Ordinance Governing MBBS Degree Course and Curriculum of Phase I & II Subjects- 2004 under I in section III relating to 1. ELIGIBILITY 1.1 Qualifying Examination the following clarifications are notified: -

Candidate having qualified 10+2 examination i.e. after 12 years of study, where the last two years of study comprise of Physics, Chemistry, Biology / Biotechnology and any other elective subject with English from a Recognized Board. Candidates must have regular, coterminous, simultaneous teaching and training in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry and Biology in Class 11 th & 12 th along with practicals in Classroom mode in a Regular School. It may be noted in the above table that recognized Board has not been defined. Hence, for the university purpose, recognized Board shall be defined as "Any Board which is recognized by the Council of Board of Secondary Education or Indian Council of Secondary Education or any Board/ Council/School which is established under an Act of the Parliament"
