Subject: Number of attempts, duration of the course for the students admitted under 2016 regulations of CCIM & the eligibility criteria for appearing to the examination for the students admitted between 2012 to 2020.

Preamble:-

There has been a circular from NCISM, vide ref No: BOA/2-B/UG/2023 Dated 18.07.2023, wherein with respect to the number of attempts and duration of the course for the students admitted under 2016 regulations of CCIM, has been modified as follows:-

“ Clause 11 (1) of NCISM (Minimum standards of UG Ayurveda Education) Regulations -22 is as under : Not withstanding anything contained in these regulations :- (ii) student who got admitted under CCIM regulations 1986, the maximum number of chances and maximum period of years to pass respective professional examination as laid down under the clauses 6 (1)(c), 2(c), 3 (c), 4(d) and 4(e) of SCHEDULE – I (as amended vide notification no 24-14/2016 (UG Regulation), Regulations, 2016 **SHALL NOT BE APPLICABLE**”

The various schemes and their starting years are as follows :-

**The regulations of CCIM has been subjected to be modified by the existing NCISM. However, the mentioned benefit given to the students



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admitted under 2016 regulations. The students admitted earlier to these regulations i.e 2016, were not been given the similar benefit (RS-4) by the NCISM, hence here the same benefit is extended to the students admitted between 2012 to 2015.

The University in its Notification vide ref No: RGU/AUTH/146-SYN/02/2019-20 Dated: 27.02.2020, has decided the carry over benefit and eligibility criteria of the students belonging to RS 4 & RS-5 scheme students in line with the CCIM rules and regulations.

The provision made by the NCISM as mentioned, is not extended to the students of the RS-4 Scheme. As the CCIM is not in prevailing now, but regulating those students who are admitted during respective years, the eligibility criteria and the scheme of the examinations for the students admitted between 2012 to 2020 i.e RS-4,RS-5 and RS-6 will have to be considered in line with the NCISM circular dated 18.07.2023. Hence the above matter was deliberated in the BOS/AC and placed before the special syndicate meeting held on 26.02.2024.

In exercise of the powers conferred under section 35 of RGUHS Act 1994 & as per the decision of the special syndicate meeting held on 26.02.2024, the number of attempts, duration of the course for the students admitted under 2016 regulations of CCIM & the eligibility criteria for appearing to the examination for the students admitted between 2012 to 2020, is notified as follows:-

I. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR THE STUDENTS WHO HAVE BEEN ADMITTED BETWEEN 2012 TO 2020:-

1. Head of the institution shall ensure that, the clause 10 (5) of CCIM – 2016 Regulations, dated 7th November 2016 (No 24-14/2016 UG Regulations) is strictly adhered to with respect to the attendance criteria for appearing in the examinations.
2. In order to appear for the first professional examinations, student shall have 75% of the attendance in the subjects of first professional course, for which the student is willing to appear.
3. In order to appear for the second professional examinations, student should have appeared for at least one subject of the first professional examination and should have 75% of the attendance in the subjects of second professional course, for which the student is willing to appear.
4. Failed students of first professional shall be allowed to appear in 2nd professional examination, but the student shall not be allowed to appear in 3rd professional examination unless the student passes all the subjects of first professional examination.
5. In order to appear for the third professional examinations, student should have appeared for at least one subject of the second professional



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- examination and should have 75% of the attendance in the subjects of third professional course, for which the student is willing to appear
6. In order to appear for the fourth professional examinations, student should have appeared for at least one subject of the third professional examination and should have 75% of the attendance in the subjects of fourth professional course, for which the student is willing to appear
 7. Failed students of second professional, who have passed all the subjects of first professional examination shall be allowed to appear in 3rd professional examination, but the student shall not be allowed to appear in final professional examination unless the student passes all the subjects of 2nd professional examination

II. THE NUMBER OF ATTEMPTS & THE MAXIMUM DURATION OF THE COURSE FOR THE STUDENTS ADMITTED BETWEEN 2012 TO 2020:-

- a. *The maximum number of chances and maximum period of years to pass respective professional examination as laid down under the clauses 6 (1)(c), 2(c), 3 (c), 4(d) and 4(e) of SCHEDULE – I of CCIM, (as amended vide notification no 24-14/2016 (UG Regulation), Regulations, 2016 **SHALL NOT BE APPLICABLE**” for the students who have been admitted between 2012 to 2020.*

III. University in its Notification vide ref No: RGU/AUTH/146-SYN/02/2019-20 Dated: 27.02.2020, has been withdrawn.

IV. The above mentioned criteria will be applicable from the ensuing examination and onwards for all the students who were admitted between 2012 to 2020, i.e for the students belonging to RS-4, RS-5 and RS-6 batches. It is not applicable for the students who are admitted under RS-7 batch onwards
