- a. A candidate must obtain 50% marks in aggregate with a minimum of 50% marks in Theory including viva-vice and minimum of 50% marks in Practical/ Clinicals, in each of the subjects.
- b. A candidate having appeared in all the subjects in the same examination and passed that examination in first attempt and secures 75% of marks or more of grand total marks prescribed will be declared to have passed the examination with **Distinction**.
- c. A candidate having appeared in all subjects in the same examination and passed that examination in the first attempt and secures 65% of marks or more but less than 75% of grand total marks prescribed will be declared to have passed the examination in **First Class**.
- d. A candidate having appeared in all the subjects in the same examination and passed that examination in the first attempt and secures 50% of marks or more but less than 65% of the grand total marks prescribed will be declared to have passed the examination in **Second Class.**
- e. A candidate passing university examination in more than one attempt shall be placed in Pass class irrespective of the percentage of marks secured by him/her in the examination.

The above revised amendments will come in to force with immediate effect.
