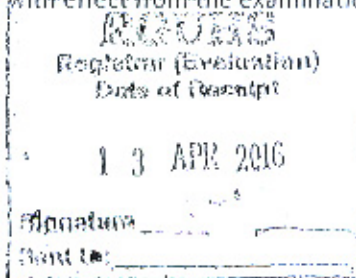

Rule -9	Carry over Benefit
	(1) (a) A candidate shall be promoted to the next year if he/she failed in one or more subjects. (b) A candidate shall pass all the papers of the previous examination before appearing for the second year examination.
	Maximum number of attempts and maximum period for completion of the course
	(1) The candidate may take any number of attempts within duration of the course. (2) Maximum duration for the successful completion of the course shall not exceed 4(Four) years from the date of admission.

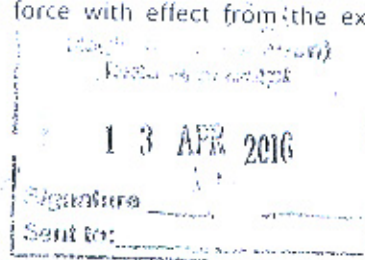

Rule -11	Carry over (1) (a) A candidate shall be promoted to the next year if he/she failed in one or more subjects. (b) A candidate shall pass all the papers of the previous examination before appearing for the fourth year examination. (2) Repealed.
Rule -12	Maximum number of attempts and maximum period for completion of the course (1) The candidate may take any number of attempts within duration of the course. (2) Maximum duration for the successful completion of the course shall not exceed 8(Eight) years from the date of admission.
