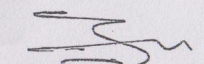

NOTE:

- In medical faculty one can be PG examiner even without guiding a PG student provided the Institute in which they are working
 - Should be a PG Institute
 - PG programmes should be running and at any given time there should be atleast one PG student in the department
- Faculty working in “Permitted colleges” may be considered as UG examiners and enrol themselves in the RGUHS examination panel from the colleges, irrespective of recognised status of the college. However to become PG examiners MCI criteria needs to be followed.
