NOTIFICATION

Sub: Rescheduling the conduct of RGUHS BPT Examinations of April

2020 and onwards.

Ref: Minutes of 148th Syndicate meeting held on 18/04/2020.

In Pursuance of the decision of the Syndicate, approval is accorded for rescheduling the conduct of RGUHS BPT Examinations of April 2020 and onwards as follows:

Conduct of BPT-I year, BPT-II year and BPT-III year Examination of April 2020

There are **TWO CATEGORIES** of students taking RGUHS Examination in April 2020

CATEGORY - I: Students eligible for carry over.

- a. A candidate who has failed in I-year is permitted to carry any two of the five main subjects and shall have to pass these subjects before appearing for the II-year examination.
- b. A candidate who has failed in II-year is permitted to carry any one of the four main subjects and shall have to pass these subjects before appearing for the III-year examination.
- c. A candidate who has failed in III-year is permitted to carry any two of the failed subjects and shall have to pass these subjects before appearing for the final year examination.

CATEGORY – II Students who are not eligible for carryover i.e. those who have failed in more subjects than stipulated.

Considering, the uncertainty prevailing from COVID-19 pandemic and concerns involved in the return of students from different parts of the country and return of students who are evacuated and taken to their native countries, the following is considered:

- 1. The CATEGORY 1 students will take the examination for their carry over subjects in September October 2020 (or during the time, the September October is scheduled considering the events following the pandemic)
- 2. These students are also be permitted to take their regular papers of their following year scheduled during September October 2020 (ONE TIME MEASURE)
- 3. In total, CATEGORY 1 students will not take more than **7 papers** during this examination
- 4. The students will have to pass ALL the papers during the September October Examination of 2020 **OR** by April May 2021 before appearing for the regular Examination of the next academic year to be conducted in September October 2021. The description to this given below

a.	A candidate who has failed in Ist-year is permitted to carry any two of the five main subjects and shall have to pass these subjects before appearing for the II-year examination. The candidate can appear for both IInd year(Failed Subject) & IIIrd Year subjects in September-October 2020. The candidate will have to pass ALL the papers of IInd-year and IIIrd-year during the September – October Examination of 2020 OR by April – May 2021 before appearing for the IV-year Examination to be conducted in September – October 2021
c.	A candidate who has failed in IIIrd - year is permitted to carry any two of the failed subjects and shall have to pass these subjects before appearing for the final year examination.	The candidate can appear for both IIIrd Year (2 Failed Subjects) & IVth year subjects in September-October 2020. The candidate will have to pass ALL the papers of IIIrd-year and IVth-year during the September – October Examination of 2020 or in the subsequent examinations to be eligible for internship and thereby eligible for the award of BPT degree.

CATEGORY - 2: Students not eligible for carry over

 a) Candidates having/ re-appearing for more than TWO papers of I-year BPT in April – May 2020 or appearing I-year BPT examination for the first time in April – May 2020. These candidates are not eligible to take the IInd-year BPT Examination in September – October 2020. 	Candidates can re-appear for more than TWO papers of Ist-year BPT in September – October Examination of 2020 or appear for Ist-year BPT examination for the first time in September – October 2020 The candidates are allowed to take the IInd-year Examination in April – May 2021 as a one-time measure considering the pandemic.	
• They would be eligible take the IInd-year BPT Examination only in April – May 2021 and shall have to pass ALL the subjects of I-year before appearing for the II-year examination.	Upon the declaration of the Ist-year BPT results of September – October 2020, if any candidate become eligible for carryover of Ist-year subjects, they are allowed to appear even for those subjects in April – May 2021 as a one-time measure considering the pandemic The candidates must pass all the papers of I-year and II-year to be eligible to appear for the III-year Examination in April – May 2022	
 b) Candidates having/ re-appearing for more than ONE papers of IInd-year BPT in April – May 2020 or appearing IInd-year BPT examination for the first time in April – May 2020 These candidates are not eligible to take the IIIrd-year BPT Examination in September – October 2020. They would be eligible take the IIIrd-year BPT Examination only in April – May 2021 and shall have to pass ALL the subjects of IInd-year before appearing for the IIIrd-year examination. 	Candidates can re-appear for more than ONE papers of IInd-year BPT in September – October Examination of 2020 or appear for II-year BPT examination for the first time in September – October Examination of 2020 The candidates are allowed to take the IIIrd-year Examination in April – May 2021 as a one-time measure considering the pandemic. • Upon the declaration of the IInd-year BPT results of September – October 2020, if any candidate become eligible for carryover of II-year subjects, they are allowed to appear even for those subjects in April – May 2021 as a one-time measure considering the pandemic.	
	• The candidates must pass all the papers of IInd-year and IIIrd-year to be eligible to appear for the IVth-year Examination in	

April - May 2022.

 c) Candidates having/ re-appearing for more than TWO papers of IIIrd-year BPT in April – May 2020 or appearing IIIrd-year BPT examination for the first time in April – May 2020

These candidates are not eligible to take the IVth-year BPT Examination in September – October 2020.

 They would be eligible take the IVthyear BPT Examination only in April – May 2021 and shall have to pass ALL the subjects of IIIrd-year before appearing for the IVth-year examination. Candidates can re-appear for more than TWO papers of IIIrd-year BPT in September – October Examination of 2020 or appear for IIIrd-year BPT examination for the first time in September – October Examination of 2020

The candidates are allowed to take the IVth-year Examination in April – May 2021 as a one-time measure considering the pandemic.

• Upon the declaration of the IIIrd-year BPT results of September – October 2020, if any candidate become eligible for carryover of IIIrd-year subjects, they are allowed to appear even for those subjects in April – May 2021 as a one-time measure considering the pandemic.

The candidates must pass all the papers of IIIrdyear and IVth-year in the April – May 2021 Examination or in the subsequent examinations to be eligible for internship and thereby eligible for the award of BPT degree.
