## CIRCULAR

Sub:	Eligibility criteria for students of PG Degree course admitted during 2021-22 and for students of PG Diploma course admitted during 2022-23, to appear for their University Examinations scheduled during First week of January 2025 and onwards

In continuation of the University Circular cited under ref(3), the revised Eligibility criteria for students of PG Degree course admitted during 2021-22 and for students of PG Diploma course admitted during 2022-23, to appear for their University Examinations scheduled during First week of January 2025 and onwards, are as follows:

### 1. Attendance:

For Three Years Course: Total days in a three years course is 1095 days. So the total working days is 939 days after deducting weekly offs (52X3 years=156). A student will require 80 per cent attendance of working days (i.e. 751 days of 939 days) for appearing in the examination. However, period of training will be extended by the same number of days for which maternity paternity leave and total excess casual leave have been availed in three years.

For Two Years Course: Total days in a two year course is 730 days. So the total working days is 626 days after deducting weekly offs (52X2 Years = 104 days). A student will require 80 percent attendance of working days (i.e. 501 days of 730 days) for appearing in the examination. However period of training will be extended by the same number of days which maternity/paternity leave and total excess casual leave have been availed in two years.

**2. Period of Training:**

The Head of the Institutions/Director/Principals shall ensure that the students complete their period of training 36 months for PG Degree and 24 months of PG Diploma before issuing the course completion certificate from the college.

3. Head of the Institution shall ensure that, a post graduate student is required complete the following during the period of his post graduate studies before applying for final examination:

present one poster presentation


Or

read one paper at a national/state conference

Or

present one research paper which should be published/accepted for publication/sent for publication
