The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor also expressed gratitude for the services rendered by Dr. Shiva Sharan K., Member of the Dental Council of India, who is completed his tenure as a Member of the Senate and Syndicate following the dissolution of the Dental Council of India.

SUBJECT NO.212/1:

ACTION TAKEN REPORT ON THE DECISION OF 209th SYNDICATE, 2010th and 210th 'A' SYNDICATE (SPL) SYNDICATE MEETINGS.

DECISION OF SYNDICATE: ATR was noted by the Syndicate.

Prof. (Dr.) C. Obul Reddy expressed concern and requested that hard copies of the agenda be provided, stating that it is not feasible to go through the entire agenda on a mobile device prior to attending the Syndicate meeting.

The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor informed the Syndicate that as the agenda comprises of more than one thousand pages, and printing and distributing hard copies to all members would be a considerable task, especially as the University has transitioned towards a paperless office. He further noted that providing laptops or iPads to all members would impose a financial burden on the University.

Prof. U. T. Iftikar Ali, Dr. Ramanath G. P., and Dr. Kiran Kumar S. Kulageri spoke on the matter and urged that iPads be provided to all Syndicate members.

Dr. Ramanath G. P. suggested that the provision of iPads could be treated as a continuous process, wherein members completing their tenure would hand over the devices for use by incoming members. He further proposed that a timeline be fixed for implementing this arrangement.

The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor agreed to the proposal, and all the members requested to issue ipads {Apple iPad Pro 13" (M5 Chip), 256 GB, esim+ Wifi} for all members of the Syndicate.

SUBJECT NO.212/2:

CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES OF 211th MEETING OF SYNDICATE (SPECIAL) HELD ON 07.02.2026 AT MADIKERI.

DELIBERATION: The Minutes of 211th Meeting of the Syndicate (Special) held on 07.02.2026 are approved.

SUBJECT NO.212/3:

TO CONSIDER THE MINUTES OF CAC MEETING HELD ON 12.03.2026.

DELIBERATION:

Dr. Ramanath G. P. expressed concern that while recommending the sanction of postgraduate seats in medical colleges, the University should thoroughly verify the availability of IPD and OPD facilities. He referred to few LIC reports the particulars of IPD and OPD were unclear. He stated that sanctioning 10 postgraduate seats under such conditions is not feasible.

The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor informed that the University has not sanctioned more than four seats for a particular subject, in accordance with the norms fixed by the NMC.

The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor clarified that the purpose of forming the LIC is precisely for such verification. The LIC report forms the basis for


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recommendations, and the University has a short window provided by the NMC to call for applications, conduct inspections, CAC & Syndicate meeting then submit to Government. Wherever deficiencies exist, they are accounted for, and recommendations are made based on LIC findings.

The Additional Chief Secretary to the Government raised objections regarding LIC reports and CAC recommendations, noting that a complaint had recently been submitted to the Hon'ble Governor's office. He urged LIC, Senate, and CAC members not to recommend blindly and to ensure that all particulars, such as IPD and OPD, are verified with supporting documents rather than just figures.

The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor confirmed that Senate members have already been informed about need for proper inspection according to the guidelines and are personally consulted, and LIC documents are thoroughly examined.

The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor further explained that the Dean's opinion is considered before presenting cases to the CAC and then to the Syndicate. If any complaints arise, the University will recheck within the prescribed timeframe. Syndicate members are also encouraged to review LIC reports beforehand and flag any issues for re-verification.

The Additional Chief Secretary reminded all LIC, Senate, and Syndicate members by virtue of being nominated to the University will be considered any action as public servants and shall be responsible for any erroneous recommendations, whether from private or government institutions alike. He emphasized that before recommending new PG courses, members should verify that the college has completed minimum years of operation and check last year's vacant seats if any, noting that over 700 PG seats remain unfilled in the last round of state counselling.

The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor clarified that about 150 seats are currently vacant according to last date of admission. For non-clinical courses, colleges without guides have not been recommended, and the same standard applies to Super Specialty courses. Any complaints received will be reverified as per RGUHS norms.

Dr. Shivakumar C. R. suggested establishing a mechanism to ensure all documents are verified before presenting to the Syndicate.

The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor assured that all documents are verified by the concerned Section and Dean of the Faculty before presentation to the CAC and Syndicate.

Other members Dr Obul Reddy, Dr. Yashodha Darshan, Dr. Ramachandra Prabhu H. D., Dr. C. Jagadeesh, Prof. U. T. Iftikar Ali, and other members discussed the matter extensively. And suggested that before Syndicate meetings, members may review LIC documents and report any complaints, which will then be rechecked by the University.

SUBJECT NO. 3(7)(2): CLARIFICATION REGARDING “NA (NOT ANSWERED) VALUATION” IN THE EVALUATION PROCESS – REG.

Ref: University notification No. RGUHS/AUTH/128thSYN/2012-13, dated 06.09.2012.

The University follows a double valuation system for answer scripts in almost all courses across various faculties. After the announcement of results, candidates are permitted to apply for photocopies of their answer


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scripts. Upon obtaining the photocopies, some of the students who have been declared failed submit representations to the University stating that they have written answers in certain questions in the answer scripts, but the evaluators have marked the same as "NA (Not Answered)". A review of such cases indicates that the number of answer scripts requiring NA valuation is very minimal in comparison to the total number of answer scripts evaluated. However, in order to bring furthermore clarity and uniformity in handling such cases of 'NA – Not answered', the following clarification is may be considered regarding "NA (Not Answered) Valuation"

1. "NA" shall mean cases where the candidate has written an answer to a question, but both the evaluators have marked the question as "NA (Not Answered)". Only such answer scripts shall be considered for further verification and valuation for the NA Questions.
2. However, in the case of MCQ-type questions, if a candidate has written the correct answer as per the University's approved key answer, but the evaluator has awarded 'Zero' marks, such answer scripts need not be sent for further valuation.
3. Instead, the marks prescribed for the respective question may be awarded to the student as per the approved key answer after due verification from Principal, BOS & Dean of the concerned faculty.
4. The representations are sent through proper channel/Principal after due verification that the student has written the answers.
5. Such Answer scripts shall be referred to the respective Chairpersons of the Board of Studies (BoS) & Dean of the concerned faculty for verification. Based on their recommendations, the answer scripts are sent for further valuation for those questions which candidate has written but evaluators have missed valuation.
6. The evaluators who mark 'NA' even when the candidate has written the answers shall be called to appear before Exam Lapses Enquiry Committee (ELEC) and a fine of 1000 may be levied for first instance.
7. And in case of repetition of such mistake by the same evaluator, he shall not be allowed for valuations for next 2 cycles of examinations.

The Process:

1. Principals / Heads of Institute to explain the existing ordinances regarding valuation to the candidates. There is no revaluation under any circumstances. Retotalling is not applicable as it is Digital valuation. '0' (ZERO) is also considered as marks as per University norms.
2. Candidate to submit application verified by the Principal within 10 days of receipt of photocopy. Applications, submitted after due date shall not be accepted.
3. The applications received shall be processed by the concerned section with necessary approvals within 20 working days.

The matter is therefore placed before the Committee of the Academic Council for consideration and approval of the above clarification regarding NA valuation.

DECISION OF CAC: After detailed deliberation the CAC approved the procedure to be adopted for NA-Valuation and recommended to issue of revised notification.

As per the recent Union Budget speech 1st February 2026, the Hon'ble Finance Minister of India has proposed the establishment of 03 New All India Institute of Ayurveda during the current financial year. Karnataka despite its strong academic base, patient load, and traditional practice of Ayurveda does not have an **AIIA**. Establishing one of these Institutes in Karnataka would be both justified and strategic.

RGUHS being one of the premier Health Science Universities of India, can take initiative to start All India Institute of Ayurveda (AIIA) in their upcoming campus at Ramanagara/Bheemanakuppe. The University having sufficient land to accommodate an AIIA can provide required land after due approvals from the competent authorities. AIIA if started, would have profound socio-economic impact and can provide an excellent environment for the research, integrated education, patient care and also students can be benefited as AIIA provides 50 percent quota for the state students.

Hence, the matter is placed before CAC and Syndicate for further perusal and orders.

AYUSH Dean's Opinion:

As of today, there are only 02 AIIA throughout the country, one in New Delhi (Established 2017) and another satellite center in Goa (Estd. 2022). RGUHS, Karnataka can play a historical role by providing necessary infrastructure to the upcoming AIIA and promote traditional Health Care System of India. Hence, requisition can be considered.

DECISION OF CAC: After detailed deliberation, the CAC unanimously approved the proposal and recommended that necessary action be taken for the establishment of the All India Institute of Ayurveda at Ramanagara / Bheemanakuppe.

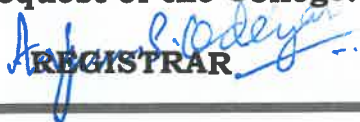

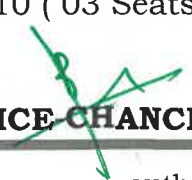

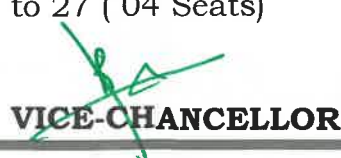

The Syndicate considered various humanitarian aspects, including the possibility of providing medical insurance, noting that ESI coverage is not applicable as the employees' salaries exceed the ₹21,000 threshold. The Syndicate also deliberated on the potential for enhancement of compensation. In this regard, it was proposed to constitute a committee to examine these issues in detail and submit appropriate recommendations.

DECISION OF SYNDICATE: After detailed deliberation, the Syndicate resolved to constitute a committee to examine the issues pertaining to outsourced employees, keeping in view of all legal aspects, including medical insurance options and the possible enhancement of compensation. The committee shall submit its recommendations before the Syndicate. Further, the matter shall be placed before the Government for consideration.

SUBJECT NO.212/5(4):

E-MAIL OF DR. DILIP KUMAR N R, SYNDICATE MEMBER COMMUNICATION ISSUED BY THE KARNATAKA GOVERNOR'S SECRETARIAT DATED 18.03.2026 (NO. GS 03 KHM 2026) ADDRESSED TO THE REGISTRAR, RGUHS.

DELIBERATION:

Dr. Dilip Kumar N. R. briefed the Syndicate on the agenda placed by him. He mentioned that the RGUHS Act, 1994 (Sections 45-48) and Statute 13.8 require "competent persons" on inspection committees. He stated that this term should be interpreted to include executive body members (Senate or Syndicate), rather than merely subject experts. He contended that Senate members possess knowledge of bylaws, Acts, statutes, and technical and infrastructure requirements, making them uniquely qualified.

The Legal Officer clarified that the term "competent person", is not defined in the RGUHS Act. In such circumstances dictionary meaning to be looked into. As per legal lexicon or dictionary meaning of "competent person" is anyone capable of conducting inspections and assisting the authority to take proper decision on the issue before it. This may include Syndicate members, Senate members, or subject experts, if the Syndicate considers such opinion useful for arriving at a proper decision.


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The majority of the Syndicate members agreed with the opinion of the Legal Officer.

Prof. (Dr.) C. Obul Reddy stated that, since the matter is in court, it is sub judice and cannot be discussed.

The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor explained that the term "competent person" has a broader meaning, and that Senate members, Deans, institutional heads, and all faculty members may be considered as competent persons.

The Syndicate discussed various possible approaches, including prioritizing the inclusion of Senate members wherever feasible, creating a pool of trained inspectors.

The meeting also addressed the distinction between inspections for fresh affiliation and continuation of affiliation. Several members expressed the view that continuation inspections should maintain the same rigorous standards as fresh affiliation.

DECISION OF SYNDICATE: After detailed deliberation, the Syndicate resolved to take appropriate action for the disposal of the court case and await the final judgment of the Hon'ble High Court.
