RATIONALIZATION OF INTAKE AND REVISION OF ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCE COURSES SANCTIONED SEATS FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2026-27.

DECISION OF ACADEMIC COUNCIL: Resolved to implement the rationalization of intake and revision of sanctioned seats for Allied Health Science courses as per NCAHP norms for the academic year 2026-27.

DECISION OF SYNDICATE: Accepted the recommendations of the Academic Council.

SUBJECT NO.214/2:

GOVERNMENT OF KARNATAKA LETTER BEARING NO. MED 3 RGU 2026, DATED 24.04.2026 REGARDING UTILIZING UNIVERSITY UG/PG ADMISSION FEE PAID BY THE GOVERNMENT MEDICAL COLLEGES IN THE STATE FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF THE INSTITUTIONS.

DECISION OF ACADEMIC COUNCIL: After detailed deliberation, the Academic Council unanimously resolved to inform the Government that the University is already facing a shortage of funds, as substantial resources are being utilized for the development of the RGUHS Campus at Ramanagara; the establishment of Medical Colleges at Ramanagara, Kanakapura, and Bagalkot; and the establishment of six skill labs across the State. Therefore, the fees collected are required for the operational expenditure of the University. Hence, it was recommended that the university fees paid by Government Medical Colleges shall not be transferred for the maintenance of the said Medical Colleges.

DECISION OF SYNDICATE: Accepted the recommendations of the Academic Council.

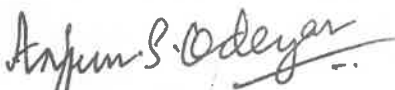
