1	AFFILIATION	Continuation of Affiliation/Fresh affiliation /Increase intake <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Affiliation will be done after COVID situation eases out.</li><li>• Affiliation decisions will be taken in the next syndicate meeting.</li><li>• Online submission for affiliation to be considered.</li></ul>

2.	<b>ADMISSION</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Admission process will be as per Karnataka Examination Authority (KEA) notifications and two officers of RGUHS are continuously following up with KEA in context to admissions.</li> <li>• For the smooth and timely allotment, list of RGUHS affiliated nursing colleges need to be updated to KEA for the academic year 2020-21.</li> </ul> <p>Honorable Vice chancellor expressed that all the Nursing colleges admission process should complete as early as possible for the academic year 2020-21 further, he stressed upon the following;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To request the government of Karnataka to finish off the admissions by September without extension for UG/PG</li> <li>• To minimize the gap. B.Sc completed and qualified students can join for MSc, immediately after completing B.Sc(N) course. Thereby MSc Admission improves. This is even applicable for MSc in Critical Care. Few principals of nursing colleges suggested for one year intensive training in critical care before joining to MSc critical care.</li> <li>• All the Nursing colleges with MSc courses, need to start MSc in critical Care (Notification &amp; admission guidelines along with age limit for in-service candidate will be framed).</li> <li>• As per the Govt of Karnataka, all BSc Nursing graduates can apply for Mid-Level Health Provider (MLHP)/Bridge course/CHO) Six months fulltime course under NHM. This will provide job opportunities and placement at Sub Centre/Health &amp; Wellness Centre directly.</li> </ul>
3	<b>ACADEMICS</b>	<p>1. Conduct of online classes and attendance for students.</p> <p>All the colleges are instructed to conduct online classes for the students using interactive online platforms such as Google Classroom, Google Hangout, Cisco Webex , You tube streaming, college Website, e mails, Internet and social media platforms, such as WhatsApp , Facebook groups etc.. (sending materials through mail / whatsapp cannot be considered as class).</p> <p>Attendance: A record of video of online classes should be preserved with the faculty/college/Library. Due to technical issues if any student is unable to attend the online class, a provision should be made to arrange</p>

		<p>special classes for such students where they can view video recorded lectures in a class room once the situation comes to normal to clarify any doubts and to consider the attendance.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The institutions will be responsible to maintain the details of classes taken subject wise , attendance, assignments given and submitted by students etc</li> </ul>
	<b>SYNOPSIS</b>	<p>I. Many principals expressed concerns about submission of synopsis without guide signatures.</p> <p>Students can submit online due to the pandemic as a one time measure without signature. However hard copies should be submitted with the signatures of their respective guides.</p>
	<b>DISSERTATION</b>	<p>I. Submission of dissertation</p> <p><b>Supplementary students:</b> Date extended, 15<sup>th</sup> May 2020 without fine and till 31<sup>st</sup> May 2020 with fine for  <b>Regular students:</b> As per the calendar of events(ref DSW/COE/2019-20 ., DATED :29.05.2019)</p>
	<b>PhD</b>	<p><b>I. RGUHS PrePhD applications for examination</b>  <b>II. Announcement of PhD entrance results.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Pre Phd examination will be conducted as early as possible.</li> <li>Phd entrance results will be announced as early as possible.</li> </ul>
		<p><b>III. PhD national consortium</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Five PhD seats to be reserved for Karnataka students out of 20 seats , the same to be preferred by Indian Nursing Council (INC to submit the affidavit).</li> <li>MOU has been extended for 5 yrs (Between INC and RGUHS)</li> </ul>
