Deliberation

Dr. S. Sacchidanand, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, RGUHS welcomed the participants and briefed about the agenda of the meeting in detail.

1. AFFILIATION (Continuation/Fresh)

Many principals expressed that due to COVID 19 situations there might be delay in the affiliation process and suggested granting continuation of affiliation for the year 2020-2021 without conducting inspection from LIC.

Discussion: LIC Inspection will be done for the year 2020-2021 as soon as the COVID 19 situation improves.

2. ADMISSION:

As per the NEET/KEA Board

Discussion: Admission process will be as per KEA notifications and two officers of RGUHS are continuously following up with KEA in admission related matters for all the courses affiliated to RGUHS.

3. INTERNSHIP:

After exams students travelled to their native and due to COVID 19 situation they are unable to travel back, so how to go with their internship joining?

Discussion: As per the guidelines to start the internship programs in their respective places and the same will be considered as an attendance.

2 to 3 months PHC/CHC programs need to be attended by the students followed by remaining internships can be done in respective places. With the permission from the Principals of Institution (Guidelines will be sent).

4. Examinations:

Remaining Practical Exams of Ayurveda, Unani & Naturopathy will be conducted after the COVID 19 ceases.

Discussion: Once all the students come back to their respective colleges the same may be informed to the University. The permission will be granted by the University to conduct the practicals by allotting the nearby College examiners.

PG Exams: will be postponed for few days or based on lockdown situations.

Payment of examination fees can be done online.

PhD Entrance Exams results will be announced within few days or as early as possible as Entrance Exam valuation is completed.

ACADEMICS:

Online classes: to compensate the 45 days of loss of academic activities portions

To complete the portions for the academic year 2020-21, online classes were started from March 23rd by using suitable technological tools by all the AYUSH Faculties to the students.

The students problems on using the technological tools was also addressed.

Discussion: To engage the students in the lockdown due to pandemic and prepare them for the coming examinations.

If any student is unable to attend online classes due to network issue, then the faculty was asked to record the online classes and make it available offline or make it available for the students during their quarantine period. The same will be

considered as an attendance for the academic year 2020-21 (following the guidelines)

Feedbacks of online classes need to be sent weekly and consolidated every month to the university as per the letter issued by RGUHS.

To continue the online classes till the COVID situation ceases.

INTERNAL ASSESSMENT:

Internal assessment is conducted:

- Only one Internal: Should conduct one more internal assessment.
- Two Internals: Average of two internals will also be considered if 3rd IA cannot be conducted.
- If possible third internals can be conducted if by exploring the possibilities of conducting the online internal assessment.

Synopsis: Hard copy should be submitted with the signature of the guide (Last date - April 30th)

Dissertation:

Submission of dissertation extended

Without fine - 15th May 2020

With fine - 30th May 2020

OTHER ISSUES:

Under Graduate Scholarship:

- SSP Portal for SC/ST students by Govt of Karnataka.
- 2) Scholarship for Poor and meritorious students

Discussion: Only one scholarship should be received by a student.

RESEARCH PROJECTS:

All the students and faculties are invited for Research work on COVID 19.

Separate project from AYUSH faculty can be taken or even integrated projects can be submitted.

Discussion: University asked to submit the research proposals from May 4th to July 15th.

AYUSH can take up only immune boosters proposals on COVID 19 (Apex body approval is required to take up the individual studies) but academic integrated studies can be sent to University as a proposal for approval.

It was informed to display COVID 19 related hoardings in all the college and hospital premises to educate students and public.
