Preamble:

As per reference (1) above, carry over guidelines for B.Sc Courses in Allied Health Sciences was framed and notification was issued on 12/12/2019. Due to prevailing Covid-19 pandemic, relaxation was accorded in the carry over benefits for the B.Sc Allied Health Sciences Courses students as per the decision of syndicate and notifications were issued on 31/05/2021 and 28/12/2021. However, as per the reference cited at (2)&(3) above, the 167th Syndicate has approved the modification to the Notification issued as per reference cited at (1) above. Hence, the following revised notification.

In exercise of the powers conferred under section 35(1) of RGUHS Act, 1994, the Syndicate in its 167th meeting held on 28/02/2022 and Hon'ble Vice Chancellor direction on 18.11.2022, have been pleased to approve the modifications in the carry over guidelines for B.sc. Courses in Allied Health Sciences as Under:

- B.Sc I year: When there are 3 to 4 subjects in an academic year, a student can carry only 1 subject to the next academic year and when there are 5 or more subjects in an academic year, a student can carry over only 2 subjects to the next academic year.
- B.Sc II year: When there are 3 or more subjects in an academic year, a student can carry over only 1subject to the next academic year.
- B.Sc III year: Before appearing for the final year examination (3rd year)the students should have cleared all the backlog of 1styear examination.
- To start the Internship the candidate should have passed all three years (1st, 2nd and 3rd year) subjects and examination.
- This will not be applicable for BPH,BHA,BPO,BOT Course.

The above guidelines are applicable from 2019-2020 batch onwards.
