Sub: Eligibility Criteria for admission to M.Pharma Courses with respect to the State Council Registration Certificate of B.Pharma Degree

Preamble:

In the Faculty meeting (ref 2), it was discussed that, the many students who are from other states, are taking admission to M.Pharma courses in the affiliated Colleges of the Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences.

The State Council Registration process of B.Pharma Degree takes considerable amount of time, due to which the admission approval of students admitted to M.Pharma Courses is getting delayed. The Eligibility Certificate from the University is denied citing the reason that, State council Registration Certificate is not produced for such B.Pharma graduates.

Students who enroll into M.Pharma course based on the B.Pharma Degree, do not practice their Pharmacy Practice in our state.

Hence, as per the recommendation of the Faculty meeting and the Ordinary Academic Council Meeting, that, the University shall issue the Eligibility certificate to such of the students who have registered their B.Pharma course in any State of India. It was approved in the 187th Syndicate meeting held on 26.08.2024.

In exercise of the powers conferred under the section 35 (1) of the RGUHS Act 1994 and Amendment Act 2013, In the 187th Syndicate meeting

held on 26.08.2024, the revised the Eligibility Criteria for M.Pharma Course with respect to the State Council Registration of B.Pharma Degree as Follows:

Existing Clause in Revised Regulations for the Master of Pharmacy Degree Programme w.e.f June-2106	Addition to Chapter-I (2) (B)
Chapter-I (2) (b): Every student selected for the admission to Post Graduate Pharmacy Programme in any PCI approved institution should have obtained registration with State Pharmacy Council or Should obtain the same within one month from the date of his/her admission failing which the admission of the candidate shall be cancelled.	(c) : <i>“The Eligibility Certificate shall be issued to those B.Pharma Graduates, who have registered their B.Pharma Degree in any of the State Councils in India and fulfills the other criteria specified in the Ordinances of M.Pharma Course issued by the University”</i>
