In exercise of the powers vested under Section 35(1) of RGUHS Act, 1994, the Syndicate in its meeting held on 30/11/2019 has been pleased to approve the carry over guidelines for B.Sc Courses in Allied Health Sciences as under :

- ❖ When there are 5 to 6 subjects in an academic year, a student can carryover only 2 subjects to the next academic year.
- ❖ When there are 3 to 4 subjects being taught in a academic year, a student can carry over only 1 subject to the next academic year.
- ❖ Before appearing for the final year examinations (3<sup>rd</sup> year) the student should have cleared all the backlog of 1<sup>st</sup> year examination.

The above Guidelines are applicable from 2019-20 batch onwards.
