In exercise of the powers vested under section 35(2) of RGUHS Act, 1994, the guidelines for assessing dissertation work shall be as below and the assessment shall be by both internal and external examiners appointed by RGUHS. Out of maximum 400 marks, 50 marks shall be for hypothesis/research questions/ need for the study, 50 marks shall be for literature survey ; 150 marks for methodology and 150 marks for results, discussion and presentation.

The format for the submission of Dissertation evaluation marks shall be as below:
