Hence, Head of the Institutions are informed to follow "As per the schedule [VIII] of Pharmacy Council of India, Gazette notification No. 14-163 / 2010-PCI, dated: 12.11.2014, the scale of pay of the teaching faculty working in Pharmacy department / college / Institutions shall not be less than the scale of pay prescribed by the State Govt / UGC / AICTE, for similar category of posts" and also follow the guidelines for faculty promotion.
